PRIZES: The board decided to give points for prizes to save on the money for the sleeve of balls that were not being used.

How to determine how many players get prizes? It is $\mathbf{1 / 3}$ of the field. Therefore, if 60 people play, then 20 people get prizes. ( 5 teams and places)
People will call looking for a team. Make every effort to find a team for the player and at times you may need to make teams.
If there are 3 man teams at the last minute ask the pro the best way to handle this. Ask someone to keep their score and they would be the blind.
